The steel cutouts for this game are life size shapes of crows, ground hogs, bobcats and coyotes. The distances from the firing line are 850, 900, 950 and 1000 yards respectively. This new shooting sport is unique to the Ridgway Rifle Club. Aficionados of long range precision shooting are being drawn to the Ridgway range to test their skills at the very challenging course of fire offered here. The high score for the day was an 18 out of 40 shot by David Preston of Greenville, second place went to Melvin Troyer of Reynoldsville with a 17.
