The 2011 Pennsylvania State Championship was held at the Ridgway Rifle Club in Ridgway, Pa. on June 25 & 26. Dave received several trophies and \$100 cash prize. Dave will receive the State Championship Trophy from the Pennsylvania Rifle & Pistol Association.

There were a total of 29 competitors for this championship match. The weather wasn't too bad with a couple rain showers over the two days, but nothing to dampen the spirits of the match attendees. There were the common Ridgway winds on both days making both spotters and shooter pay particular attention to shot placement.
