HIGHPOWER RIFLE AND HIGHPOWER HUNTING RIFLE SILHOUTTE MATCHES

- DATES:** MONTHLY - April 18th, July 18th, August 22nd, September 19th
SPECIAL – Eastern Regional Sierra Classic May 15th and 16th
- ENTRY RULES:** Entry Fee will be \$12.00 for one gun and \$20.00 for those wishing to complete in both standard and hunting class. Fees for Seniors 60 and over and also Juniors 16 and under will be \$6.00 for on gun and \$12.00 for two guns.
If you do not have a 2010 N.R.A. silhouette classification book, you will be required to purchase one from the statistical officer or you will not be eligible for any awards. All current N.R.A silhouette rules apply.
- TIME:** 8:00A.M. TO 9:15 A.M. – Sight in and registration
9:30 A.M. TO 10.00 A.M. – Match starts. (Late entries will be accepted until the last relay has been called to the firing line.)
- PROGRAM:** Match will consist of one 60 shot Match –Standard Rifle with one 40 shot Match for hunter Rifle to be shot in conjunction.
- AWARDS:** Match winner, 2nd open and class awards of 2 entries – 1 award; 5 entries – 2 awards; 7 or more – 3 awards. A lone shooter in any class will be placed in the next higher class. If we have a lone master shooter, he will be eligible for open awards only. Unclassified shooters will shoot in the highest class of the day. Hunting rifle awards will be done likewise. 5 and 10 in a row, pins will be awarded. (Master and AAA 10 in a row only)
- SAFETY:** All persons on the firing line are urged to wear eye and ear protection.
- INFORMATION:** Men and women's rest rooms are available and all firing points are covered. A light lunch will be available.
