HIGHPOWER RIFLE SILHOUTTE MATCHES

- DATES:** MONTHLY - April 11th, May 2nd
State Championship June 6th
- ENTRY RULES:** The match will be \$10.00 for each rifle per match. \$15.00 for the State Match. An NRA Classification book is required for all competitors. High Power Semi-Automatic Military and Vintage Military Bolt Guns are allowed. All current N.R.A silhouette rules apply.
- TIME:** 8:00A.M. TO 9:30 A.M. – Sight in and registration
10.00 A.M. – Match starts. (Late entries will be accepted until the last relay has been called to the firing line.)
- PROGRAM:** All Matches will be NRA approved consisting of 40 round matches each day, one in the morning and one in the afternoon provided there are enough entries. If you want to shoot in the afternoon match you must shoot in the morning match.
- COURSE OF FIRE:** 10 shots- Chickens at 200 Meters
10 shots- Pigs at 300 Meters
10 shots- Turkeys at 385 Meters
10 shots- Rams at 500 Meters
- AWARDS:** Awards will be enameled Hat pins given to Match Winner, First and Second in each class. State records will be established at the State Match and posted on the Ridgway Rifle Club Website.
- SAFETY:** All persons on the firing line are urged to wear eye and ear protection.
- INFORMATION:** Men and women's rest rooms are available and all firing points are covered. Competitors may be required to assist in setting targets during the monthly match. We will have target setters for the State Championship. No ammunition may be used that could cause damage to the steel silhouettes such as armor piercing. 6mm is the minimum caliber allowed.
